REPORT ON PREVIOUS MEETING  
*The new TPC OB Truck:  
Producing 5.1 Audio for HDTV*

Around 28 people came together at this evening to visit the new HD OB truck. After welcoming the people, Peter Flückiger introduced himself and his two colleagues. Then the visitors were split into two groups and taken to different tours. After the tours had finished, the groups were exchanged. One tour was with Peter Jucker who explained the overall project and the video installation. The truck has about the largest size which is allowed on European roads. It can expand on both sides over the full length. This gives a huge working complex with workplaces for up to 22 people.

Up to 24 HD cameras can be used simultaneously; currently a maximum number of 16 are used. The other tour was the audio tour. Here, Peter Flückiger explained the overall workflow of the audio part with some special

aspects. It became clear that sports events are technically the most challenging. Then, Willi Zürrer showed their new StageTec Aurus console and explained the difficulties which are important with 5.1 broadcast, like proper audio monitoring as well as the downmix issue. Whereas the majority of today's spectators are listening in stereo, there are some listening in surround but also some which listen in mono. Both needs are to be satisfied.

Another visit was made to the production studio, where some excerpts of the many HD productions were shown, which the tpc does for the Opernhaus Zürich.

The AES Swiss Section warmly thanks the speakers and the tpc for a very interesting evening.
